School Budget Increases

Staff employment, by type of assignment, shows

that School Districts enjoyed a **74.9**% increase; School Principals and Assistant Principals grew by **33.4**%; and, Teachers had a meager **7.7**% increase. *Enrollments were almost flat at 1.9*%. The total increase during that period was **116**%, with Teachers accounting for less than **0.07**%.
