Teachers should be compensated based on qualifications — knowledge; experience; instructional skills; student outcomes; civic virtue and character development.

Exceptional teachers deserve exceptional compensation.

Deciding requires <u>re-thinking</u> how education is developed, packaged, and delivered to different learners, with different needs — effectively and efficiently.
