

Public Schools are not intended to make a profit. They are also not intended to fail and go into bankruptcy. The proposed system accomplishes the goal of *Excellence In Education*, while controlling costs as a fiduciary responsibility owed to Citizens.



Much of the work of reforming education will be accomplished by *enacting the Education Bill Of Rights*. The legislation establishes Standards, Expectations, and Policies that Citizens demand as **their education rights**. The current system failed because School Boards have no Enforceable Standards. **Policies change by elections**; typically by a one member majority, that has a politically driven special interest agenda.



Once standards and policies are established, the next phase of reform is Compliance. The regulations mandated by the *Education Policy and Oversight Commission* will govern School operations. Commissioners will be assigned to School Districts, and will supervise the management of four Commission Offices, that will oversee: School Policies; Curriculum and Instruction; Accounting; Human Resources; Administration; and, the successful **implementation of the Education Bill Of Rights laws**.
