When two generations of homeschoolers graduate with <u>honors</u> from **Oxford University**, you have to ask the obvious question: "<u>Why</u> are homeschoolers thriving, and public schoolers failing?"

Oxford and Cambridge Universities are ranked as the <u>best</u> education systems in the world; even though <u>students only spend a portion of their time in class</u>. They are **independent learners** that meet with teachers in small groups to talk in-depth about the course's content, which is then used for **self-directed study.** Education is <u>personalized</u>. (Homeschooling uses similar teaching methods.)

The Reformed Education System will have "<u>Conversations</u>" with Teachers tutorials that supplement classroom instruction to help students <u>achieve</u> their <u>full</u> academic <u>potential</u>. There will also be "<u>Buddies</u>" — students knowledgeable about course content that help other students learn.
