Clause 15

All Educational Institutions operating in the State must comply.

State licensed institutions that violate statutes will loose funding and non-profit status. Penalties will be imposed until violations are corrected.

The Legal and Compliance Office has authority to monitor School Operations. (Exceptions for non-public funded schools.) Complaints can be anonymously reported.

Clause 16

Parents have rights to direct their children's education.

The Constitution protects the fundamental rights of parents to educate their children by selecting schools that reflect their values and beliefs.

School Choice will be available to Taxpaying Citizens of the State. Vouchers will be issued based on taxes paid. Exemptions for financial hardships will apply. Illegal Aliens are <u>criminals</u> not entitled to receive taxpayer funded education.
