## Clause 23

## Indoctrination, in any form, is strictly prohibited.

Teachers, and Administrators, are required to abide by the policies, and performance requirements, stated in their employment agreements.

Any intent, or action, to indoctrinate students will result in immediate termination.

Citizens control public education; and, determine what is taught in Schools.

## Clause 24

## States have the exclusive right to regulate education.

The Federal Department of Education (DOE), does <u>not</u> have authority to infringe upon State Rights protected by Article X of the Constitution.

The DOE "strong-arms schools through unilateral statutory expansion", that is unconstitutional. States retain sovereign powers to enact and enforce laws.

The DOE should not exist. Citizens control Schools, not the government.
