Innovative <u>instructional designs</u> will help grow the new curricular development model, as relationships are formed with **Partners and Other Resources**— research analysts; subject matter experts; educational consultants; focus groups.

The use of technology enables students to <u>access more content on demand</u>, at a pace consistent with their lifestyle. It doesn't matter **how** they learn, as long as they are learning; enriching their minds; and, improving their lives.

The goal is to make every student an independent learner.

School competition is essential to reviving our dead education system.

By ranking the success of schools in *improving student outcomes*, we provide a more <u>equitable distribution</u> <u>of resources</u>. Failing schools that improve performance, will receive a higher <u>weighted ranking</u> than schools that maintain the status quo.
