EDUCATION STATISTICS

During the past 10 year period, 2012-2022, average Current Spending per student increased from \$13,469 to \$14,360 (6.6%). Current Spending does not include Capital Outlay (\$1,499) and Interest (\$420), bringing the Total to \$16,279.

Total expenditures for K-12 public schools are \$800 Billion (2020-21 dollars).

Administrative, and other expenditures, account for \$518.5 Billion (64.8%); and, include: salaries; \$425.6 B employee benefits; purchased services; capital (53.2%) outlay; interest; supplies; and, other expenses. Instruction (Teacher Salaries) are \$208.4 Billion Instruction (26.1%) based on the national average salary of
